

Bunt play #1 “White” – Man on 1st - Goal is get an out at 1st base.

1. Third base gets sign from dugout, steps inside of infield and calls out, “White.” Immediately reminds catcher to replace.
 2. Pitcher comes set, looks at home (2 secs).
 3. Third base crashes – Hustles back to 3rd if does not field bunt. Catcher covers 3rd if third base fields it.
 4. First base – holds runner on until pitch then reads a hard bunt past the mound to foul line perpendicular.
 5. Pitcher has inside the mound in front and to 1st base line.
 6. Shortstop – covers 2nd base.
 7. Second base – covers first base. Cheats two steps in double play depth in set up. Shuffles on show of bunt.
 8. Catcher calls play (loud & clear, 1,1,1, or 2,2,2) fields all bunts close to home plate.
 9. Outfield backs up bases.
 10. If ball is bunted through, it is an automatic throw to first baseman on a pick.
- ** If bad bunt hit hard, get the lead runner! **
